CAMPUS FACILITIES

- 1. Fee Concession: The students who secure 95% of marks and above in the qualifying examinations will receive 100% fee exemption. Those who score more than 90% and less than 95% marks will get fee concession. Special fee concession will be extended to the outstanding sports persons at the time of admission to first degree. The exemption/concession will be granted on first come, first serve basis. Special Fee concession will be given to the first 15 students seeking admission to I year B.A.**

2. **Faculty:** The college is privileged to have a band of well experienced and committed teachers who can impart quality education and provide a healthy academic environment to the students.
3. **Library:** The college library is fully automated. It has a vast collection of books and journals. Book Bank facility is available to deserving students. Internet facility is also provided in the Library. The library is subscribing for NLIST e-resources also.
4. **Science Laboratories:** Well equipped Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology Laboratories are housed in spacious, well lit and well ventilated halls. The Zoology Laboratory has an attractive Zoology Museum too.
5. **Computer Laboratory:** To keep pace with the modern times, two well-equipped computer laboratories have been set up.
6. **English Language Laboratory:** The College has a language laboratory equipped with computers having software to train the students in the English language. Lessons on pronunciation and grammar are imparted to the students who enroll for Communicative English course.
7. **Commerce Laboratory:** A Commerce Laboratory has been set up for conducting certificate courses and other activities related to Commerce and Management.
8. **Computer Centre with Internet facility:** A full-fledged computer centre has been established with Internet facility to enable the students to keep in touch with the global information and acquire knowledge.
9. **Remedial coaching:** Compulsory remedial coaching is given to slow learners and it is free of cost.

- 10. Audio-visual room:** An audio-visual room with Computers, LCD Projectors, Smart Board, DVD, etc. are available.
- 11. Seminar Hall:** A seminar hall equipped with a smart board, an LCD projector, a surround sound system has been set up.
- 12. Mentoring System:** Trained teachers take care of students with respect to their academic pursuits and related problems.
- 13. Career Guidance & Placement Cell:** A career guidance cell functions and provides necessary literature, information and training to students to pursue career opportunities. The Placement Cell also organizes Job Fair, Campus Drives and Training Programmes for students.

- 15. Ladies Hostel:** Hostel facility is provided to female students of the institution. The hostel has spacious rooms and all modern amenities.

- 20. Sports and Games:** The College has an extensive and well maintained play field for cricket and other sports. It also has courts for Basket Ball, Kabaddi, Ball Badminton and Throw Ball. Student Faculty

The select senior students are sent to junior classes to give lectures on chosen topics. This is done with the objective of helping the senior students to have an in-house training programme.

Eligibility for Admission to Degree Course:

1. A Candidate who has passed the two year Pre-University Examination conducted by the Board of Pre-University Education in Karnataka or any other examination considered as equivalent to it, is eligible for admission to the first year Degree Course.

Admission Procedures

1. The applicant should pay Rs.150/- at the college office Towards the application form and Prospectus including Registration fee. Any applicant who wishes to get the application form and the Prospectus by post will have to remit Rs.175/- by D.D. to the Principal, S.V.S. College, Bantwal.
2. Filled in application form should reach the Principal immediately after the publication of the results of the qualifying examination (P.U.C.).

3. A provisional selection of the candidates for admission to various courses will be made taking into consideration their academic record and other activities as shown in the application and as per the Govt. regulation.
4. **The candidates so selected will be called for an interview at the college and they should be present on the date and time given for interview accompanied by their parent or guardian. They should submit the following Certificates at the time of interview:**
 - a) Cumulative Records (S.S.L.C.) - original.
 - b) Statement of marks of the qualifying examination S.S.L.C. or P.U.C. - original & a xerox copy.
 - c) Transfer Certificate from the institution last attended - original and xerox.
 - d) Conduct Certificate from the head of the institution last studied - original.
 - e) Caste / Income Certificates in the prescribed form - original & xerox copy.
 - f) Migration Certificate and Pass Certificate [for non Karnataka Students]
 - g) Two Passport size Photos.
5. All admissions made are **provisional** and they are subject to approval by Mangalore University.
6. The admission order will lapse if the candidate does not pay the fees before the dates prescribed for payment.

7. The candidates withdrawing from the college after their admission will have to forego all fees paid by them. If a Student's name is on the rolls of the college for any part of a term he/she will be required to pay the fee for the entire year.
 8. The mere registration of the application at the college office is no guarantee of selection for admission.
 9. The principal may refuse admission to any student without assigning any reason.
 10. Admission for any course is made for one academic year only. Student will be admitted to the next higher class (in the subsequent academic years) on the basis of fresh application for re-admission to that class taking into account their progress, conduct & regularity in attendance during the previous year.
- **Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) is installed on the campus.**
 - **Any kind of unlawful activity detected on the campus will be strictly dealt with.**

Uniform:

All the students have to compulsorily wear the uniform prescribed by the college on all occasions in the college.

Besides, no student shall wear hat, shawl, rumalu or head scarf on the campus.
